HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

Mission Statement for the School:

Vision of the School:

For all of our children to have the opportunity to explore their unique potential, develop their imagination and self belief and foster the positive attitudes, skills, knowledge and understanding that will enable them to thrive as life-long learners who are able to achieve their goals and live a full and rewarding life.

The Home School Agreement acts as a clear starting point for pupils, parents and school staff. It supports all aspects of the school philosophy and vision and the collective roles of all individuals in ensuring that they work together effectively. The Agreement can be updated after undertaking surveys with parents, school staff, pupils and Governors.

Pupils will try to:

- Attend school regularly and arrive on time.
- Work as hard as I can and take pride in all that I do.
- Tell a teacher or grown-up if I am upset or unhappy.
- Try to be helpful and thoughtful to others and not cause them harm through actions or words.
- Do my best with my home learning and school tasks.
- Respect the school environment and other people’s belongings.

The School will:

- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum.
- Be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the learning of your children.
- Contact you if there is a problem with attendance or punctuality.
- Keep you informed about how your child is doing in all aspects of school life through reports, parent evenings, phone calls, letters and invitations to meetings.
- Let you know when your child is doing well.
- Let you know if there are any concerns or problems that affect your child’s work or behavior, and support the needs of all children.
- Ensure that there are regular times during the school year when you have an opportunity to share in the life of the school.
- Keep you informed about key changes and ways you can support your children through workshops and meetings.
- Ensure that there is appropriate provision to seek the views of all members of the school community.
- Ensure that the required dress code is adhered to by all children.
- Arrange times in advance to ensure that you have the maximum opportunity to attend school events and meetings.

The Home will:

- Ensure that my child goes to school and on time, and fully support the school's attendance policy, and provide an explanation as soon as possible when your child is absent.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour.
- Fully support the various school policies and guidelines including the Behaviour Policy.
- Get to know about my child's life at school and attend Parents' Evenings and any discussions about my child's progress.
- Support the School Dress Code.
- Support the school's policy ensuring that staff and pupils work in a safe environment.
- Support my child in home learning and other opportunities for home learning.
- Encourage the appropriate safe use of ICT equipment outside school hours to ensure that this does not contain material which could be deemed as "cyber-bullying" by the recipient.
